We have been advocating for better city/state policies to improve and safeguard our home investment and lifestyle since 2004. In 2011 three Oceanside City Councilmen eliminated rent control, and the new ordinance allowed rent increases without limit. Esther Sanchez helped OMHA build a coalition of groups to defeat this effort by adding an initiative to the ballot in 2012 to keep rent control and we were successful!
